Final suspect captured in recent La Porte murder case

Residents of La Porte and her surrounding communities can rest easier knowing that 19 year-old Craig Lamont Williams Jr. is now in police custody.

Williams was the final suspect remaining at large after a trio of Baytown and La Porte suspects were charged with capital murder for the January 15th shooting death of 30 year-old Marcus Green. The event occurred in the courtyard of a La Porte apartment complex during the early morning hours of January 15th.

While LPPD officers, detectives, and crime scene investigators are to be credited with the quick identification of all suspects, and apprehension of 27 year-old Cornay Crawford, and 18 year-old Cheyenne Marie Totten within days, Williams remained at-large. Fortunately, additional investigative efforts from regional law enforcement agencies, specifically including a series of activities conducted by Lake Charles Police Department, resulted in the location and capture of Williams on the evening of January 27th, where he was found in Lake Charles, LA.

After processing and concluding investigative efforts have been wrapped-up, Williams will be returned to Texas, where he and both Crawford and Totten await trial for their Capital Murder charges.
