3rd week in a row LPPD investigators snatch meth from area residence

Narcotics search warrants, seizure of vast amounts of narcotics, and confiscation of handguns and other accessories to drug distribution efforts have become more frequent due to the efforts of La Porte Police Department's Street Crimes Unit.

For their latest achievement, the Unit, along with the assistance of several other LPPD officers from neighboring divisions, executed a narcotic search warrant during the afternoon of April 26th, at a La Porte residence located in the 1600 block of Brook Meadow. As a result, La Porte residents Steven Hall – 19 years of age, and 22 year old Elizabeth Kopycinski were each arrested and charged with Possession of a Controlled Substance with intent to deliver, while a deadly weapon enhancement charge was added as well.

Inside of the residence, investigators located over 4 ounces of crystal meth, along with assorted pills, baggies for packaging, a digital scale, and a 9mm handgun – all items consistent with drug trafficking activities.
