results in identification of felon, arrest warrant issued**

On the afternoon of May 31st, a La Porte Resident at the Pelican Bay Townhome complex discovered that their bicycle had been stolen from a residence garage. After reporting the offense to Police, the assigned investigator was able to quickly track the bicycle down to an area pawn shop. Follow up interviews with the victim, area residents, and the pawn shop staff led to the identification of 39 year old Amoyo Mills of Houston.

After presenting the facts to the Harris County District Attorney's Office, Felony-level Burglary charges were accepted, and an arrest warrant is now active for Amoyo Mills.
