Workers at La Porte spa charged with prostitution, PD petitions City to revoke business permit

On September 7th, 2016, investigators with La Porte Police Department's Street Crimes Unit successfully concluded a vice-related investigation at the Jing Day Spa located in the 1300 block of La Porte's West Fairmont Parkway. As a result, massage therapists Hui Jiang (49 year old Houston resident) and Guizhi Chen (35 year old resident, recently relocated from New Orleans) were separately charged through the Harris County District Attorney's Office for misdemeanor Prostitution, a class B offense.

Upon further investigation, it was determined that the owner of the establishment, Jian Cao, had violated the City of La Porte's ordinance for operating a massage studio. Jian Cao will be summoned to appear in the City of La Porte Municipal Court for two counts of Failing to Notify of Changes in Employment for new Employees.

Because of the combined violations, the police department, in accordance with the City's recently enacted Massage Business Ordinance, is in the process of petitioning the City to revoke Jung Day Spa's permit to operate a massage business within the City.
