La Porte's Street Crimes Detectives arrest yet another pair for illegal drug sales

Wednesday October 5th was highlighted by La Porte Police Street Crimes Unit concluding a multi-week investigation, after receiving citizen complaints regarding possible drug activity at a residence in the 8500 block of Collingdale Road.

A series of surveillance efforts had identified 22 year-old La Porte resident Shari Breaux as a suspect, and on October 5th Breaux was stopped after committing a traffic violation. She was subsequently arrested for driving with a suspended license. Soon after, the front seat passenger, identified as 31 year-old Brandon Morrison, was arrested on Felony Probation Violation Warrant issued out of Harris County for Theft.

The Street Crimes Unit then returned to Breaux's Collingdale residence and received consent to search Breaux's bedroom, where she was alleged to have been storing narcotics.

Approximately 44 grams of crystal methamphetamine was seized from Breaux's room, along with numerous plastic bags and a digital scale. After detectives consulted with the Harris County DA's Office, a charge Possession of a Controlled Substance with Intent to Deliver was filed on Breaux.
