



Car burglary suspects arrested after chase

La Porte police arrested two men accused of burglarizing cars after a two mile chase. Detectives said David Gilliam, 20, and Donald Edmond, 24, were following bank customers who left with large amounts of cash. Investigators said the pair would follow people from the bank and wait for them to leave their vehicles with the cash inside. Police watched the two follow an undercover detective from a Bank of America in La Porte to a Kroger at 3500 Spencer Highway in Pasadena on Thursday afternoon. The detective had received a bank bag full of paper instead of money as part of

the sting. When the suspects tried breaking into the vehicle, police attempted to arrest them. Detectives said Gilliam and Edmond drove off and led police on a two mile chase that ended when they crashed into a pole at Pasadena Boulevard and Jackson Avenue. Both tried running away on foot but were captured. Gilliam is charged with burglary of a motor vehicle. Edmond is charged with evading in a vehicle. Police believe the two may be suspects in other crimes.
