Meeting Minutes

June 11, 2015

Call To Order

Clayton Hackett called to order the regular meeting of the LEPC on **June 11, 2015** at 11:31 a.m. at 2015 Sens Road, La Porte, Texas.

a) Emergency Communications – Jeff Suggs:

2. Reverse Drills

- a. 5/15/15 @ 0200 hours: DuPont – Maltoney called back several times asking question and giving updates about speaking with a supervisor at the plant by no emerge response was sent.

Spoke with many people from other LEPCs and those who live in La Porte who were in attendance. The LEPC looks forward to participating next year as well.

g) **Treasurer's Report:** We received \$6,700 this month from member contributions and golf tournament registrations. Total Disbursements of \$7,821.16 which included lunch, secretarial services, expenses for the Wally SIP Program, Whelen siren repairs and a going away gift for Jeff Suggs. Ending Balance as of May 31, 2015 was \$92,123.09.

In addition, the State is working to update the LEPC Handbook in regards to transportation and they want 3-6 LEPCs to participate in the focus group to do so, one of those being the La Porte LEPC. He will let us know once there is more information on this.
- Presentation by Charles Roeseler, National Weather Service regarding the forecast for the upcoming hurricane season
- Kristin Gauthier wanted to let everyone know the Industry Ride Out Shelter is still available at Baker 6th Grade Campus and to please let her know if your facility plans to use it, and if so, how many people can they expect.
