

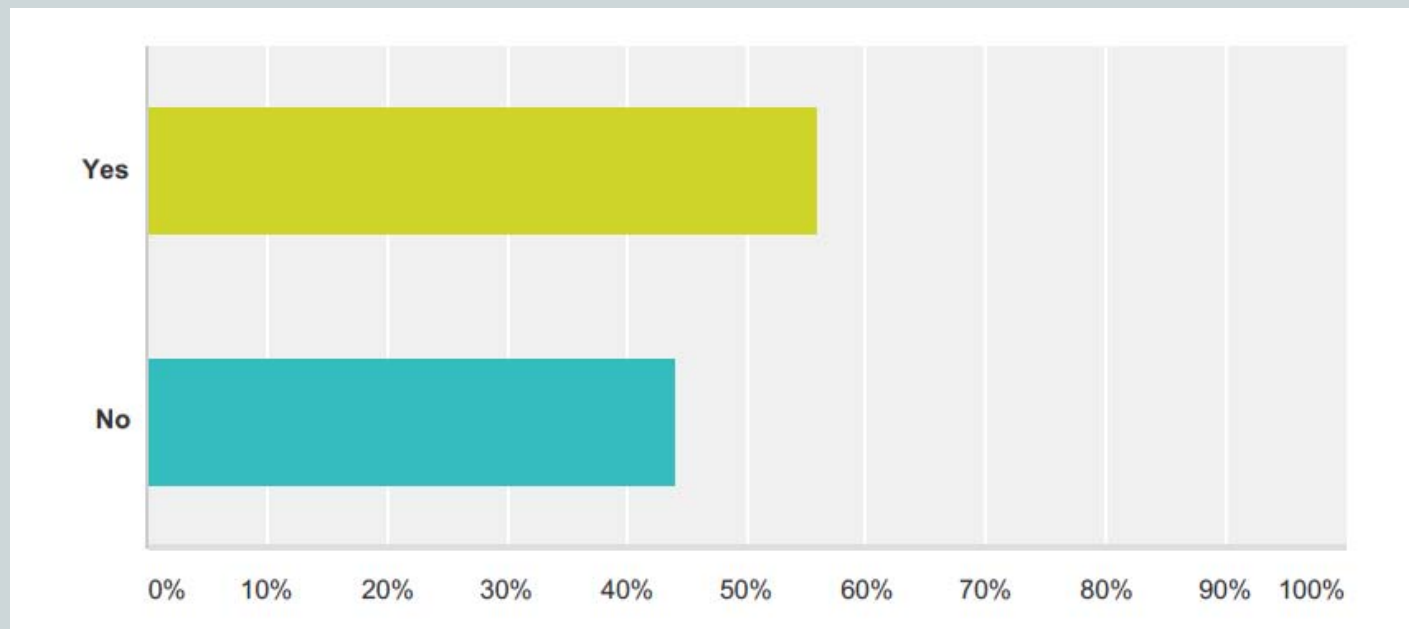
LEPC MEMBER SURVEY RESULTS



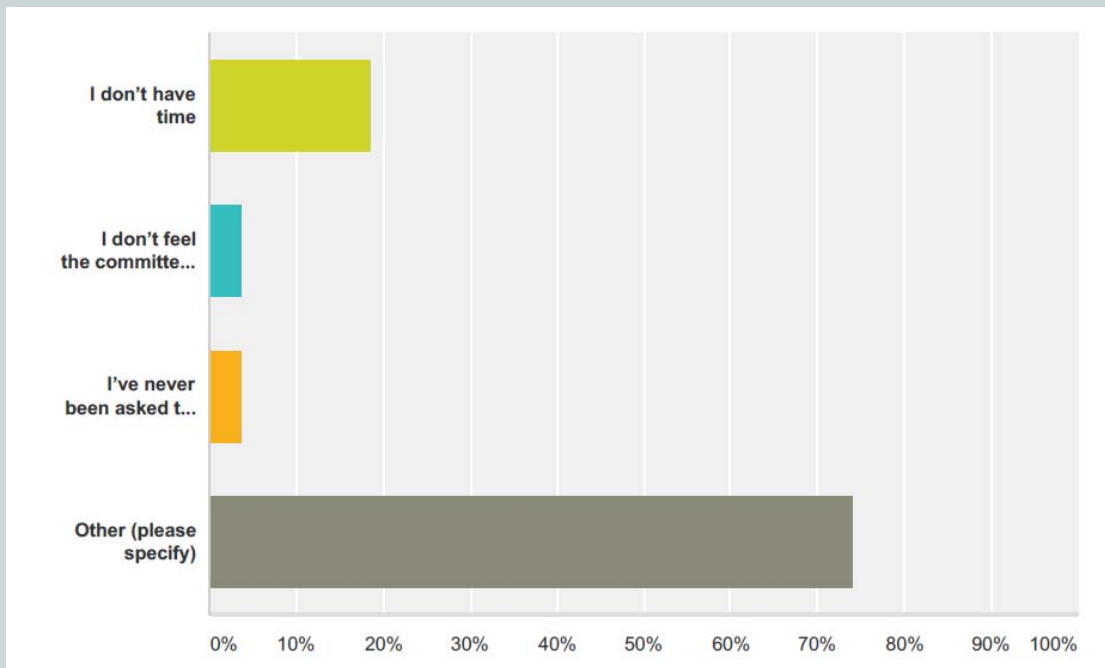
Q1: HOW LONG HAVE YOU BEEN ATTENDING LEPC MEETINGS?

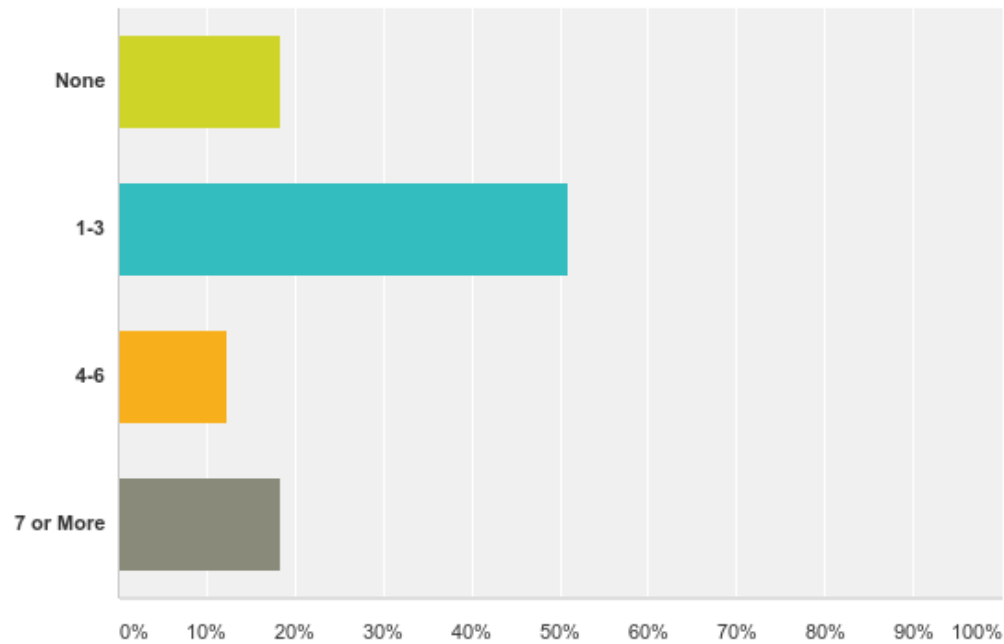
Q3: IF YOU DON'T ACTIVELY PARTICIPATE IN A COMMITTEE, WHY NOT?



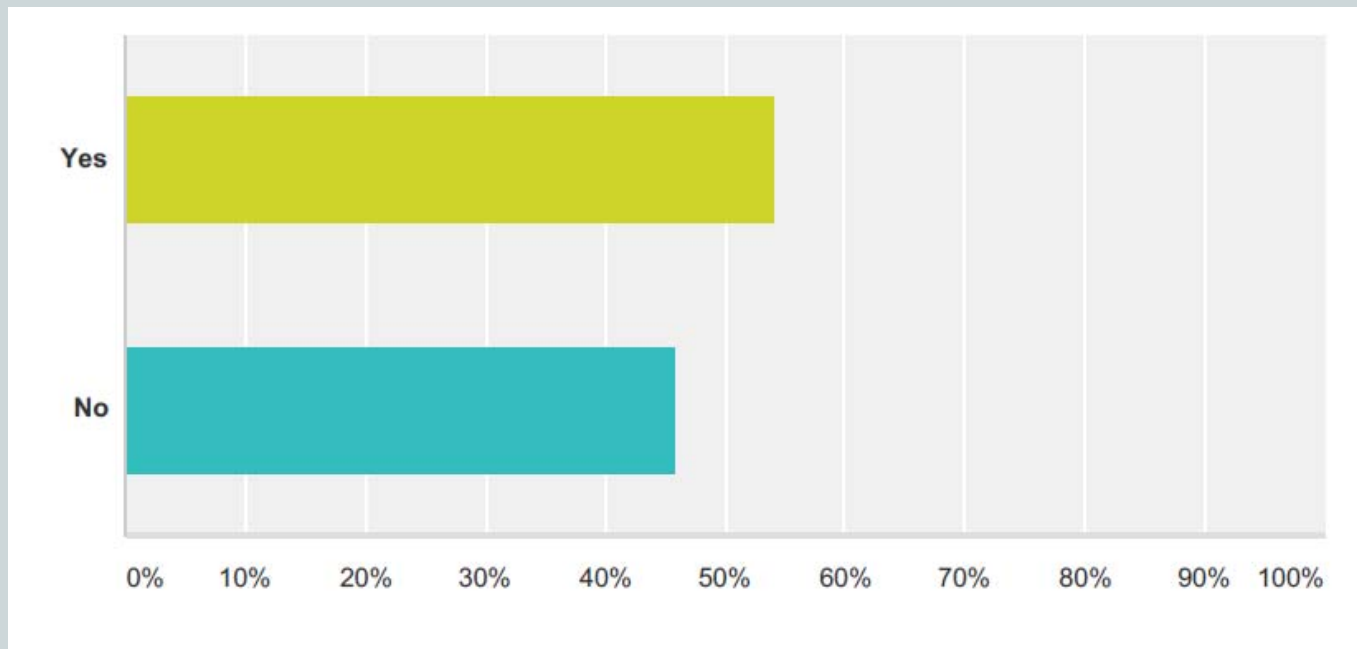
Other:

- Some have to attend other LEPC meetings and don't have time to actively participate

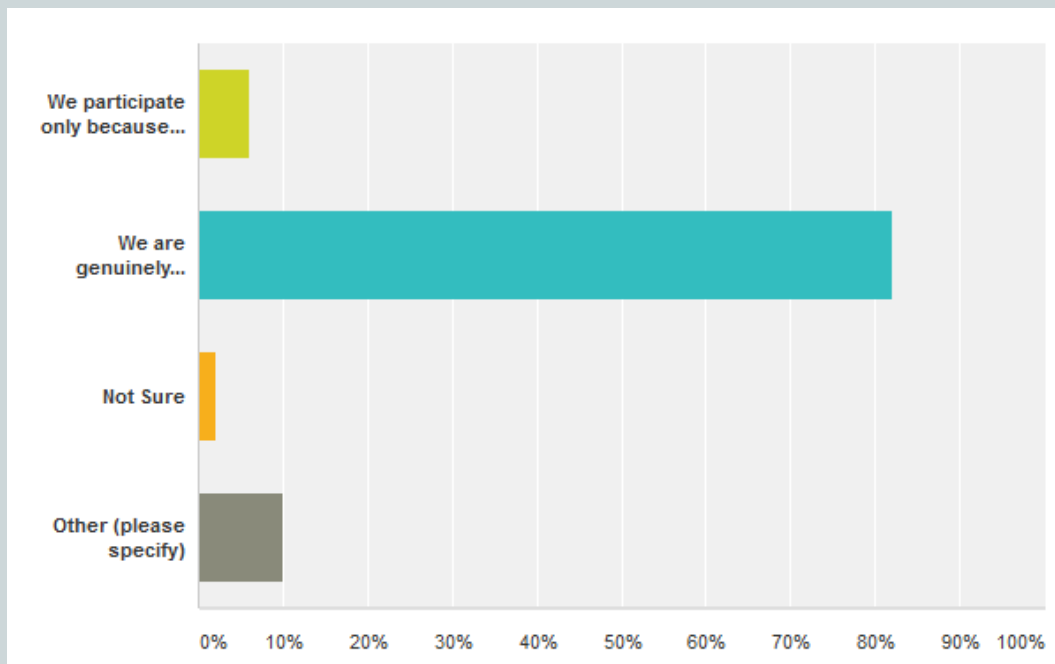
Q4: HOW MANY LEPC EVENTS (NOT MEETINGS) DID YOU ATTEND IN 2016?

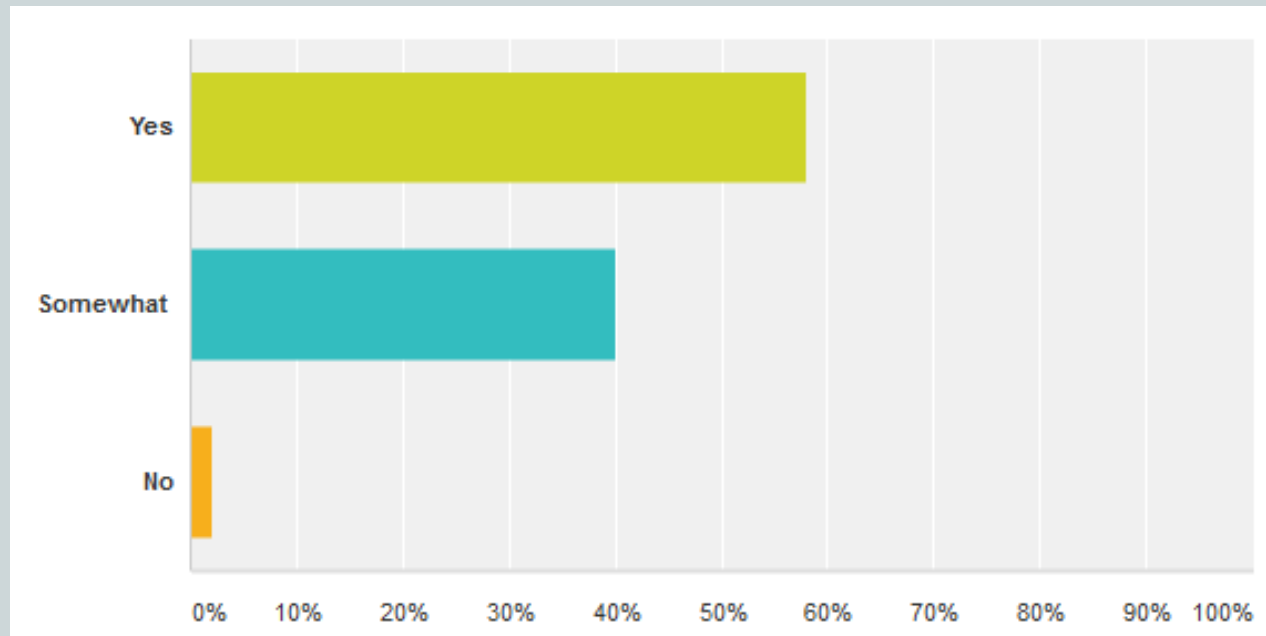

ER Plan Best Practices and Drill Planning. Annual emerge training. There are a lot of people that move into these positions and they may not understand these systems.

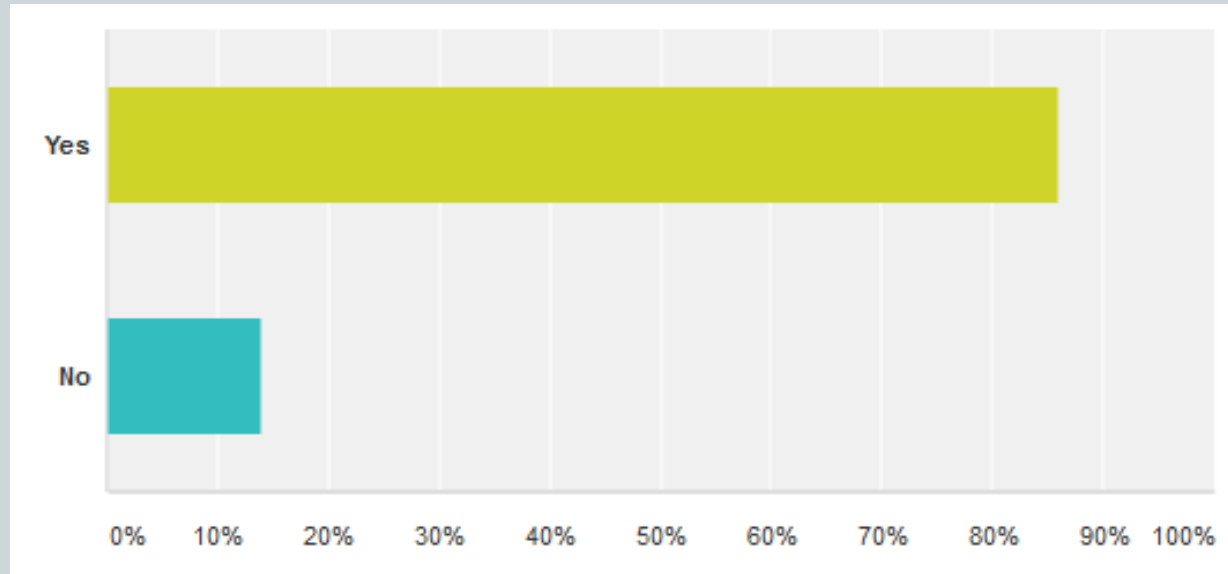
Best practices of those companies with an excellent safety record. LPCAC does this and I have found those presentations very helpful.

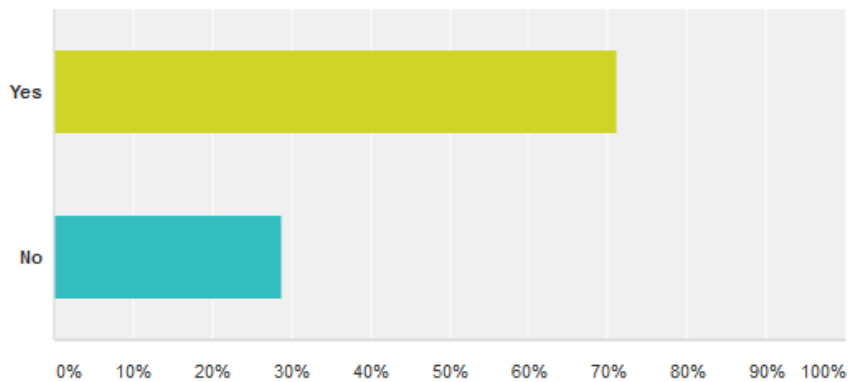
Presentations need to provide greater details of the hazards that could affect the community, processes in place for protection of the facility community and emergency response capabilities.

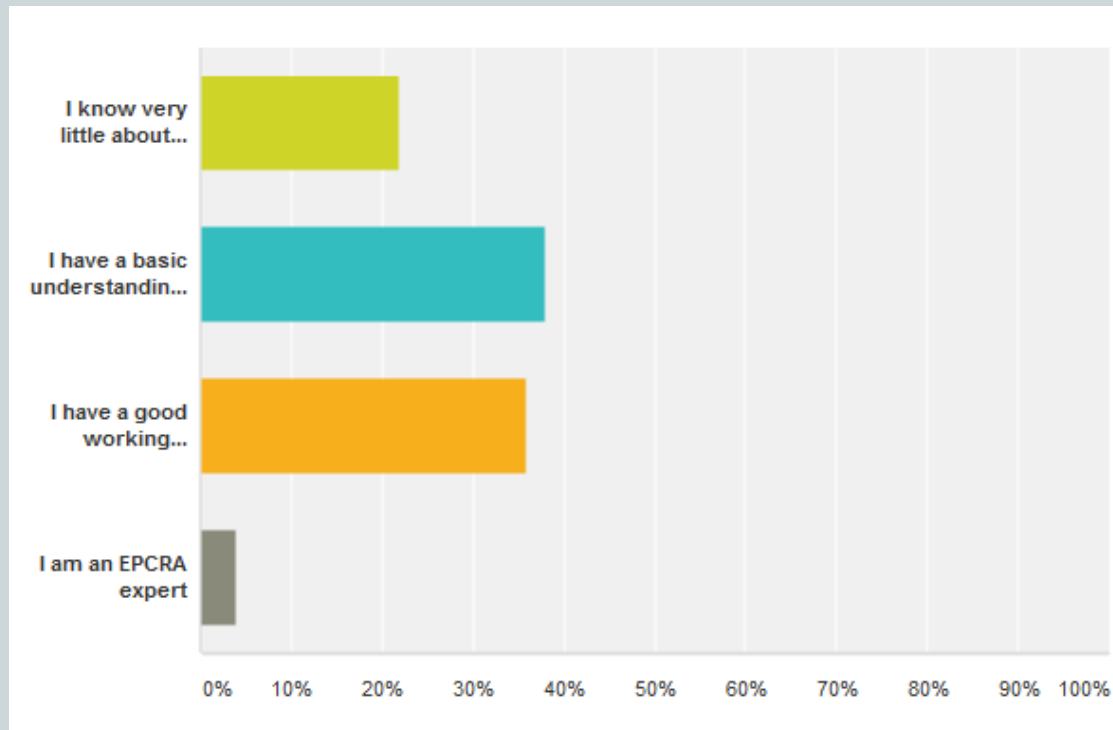
Q10: WOULD YOU LIKE TO SEE THE LEPC HOST OR CONDUCT TRAINING FOR MEMBERS?

Suggestions:

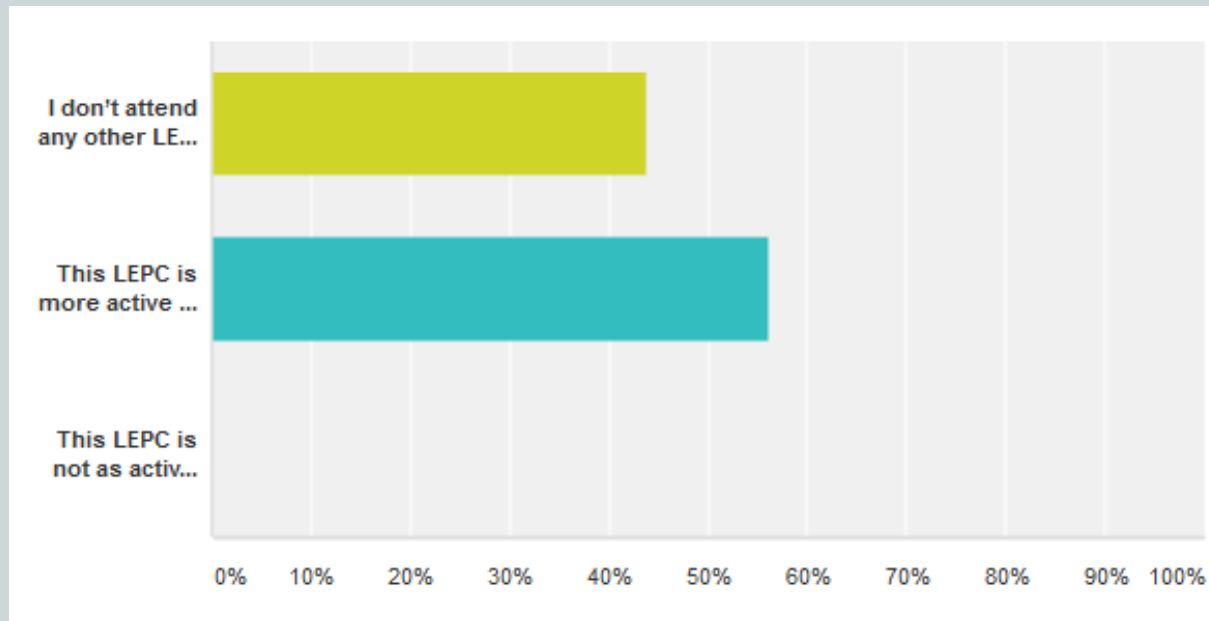
- **Drill for an outdoor event (football game, festival)**

- **Scholarship program for member's children or grandchildren. Include their involvement in one or more of these community outreach programs as a prerequisite to qualify for the award.**

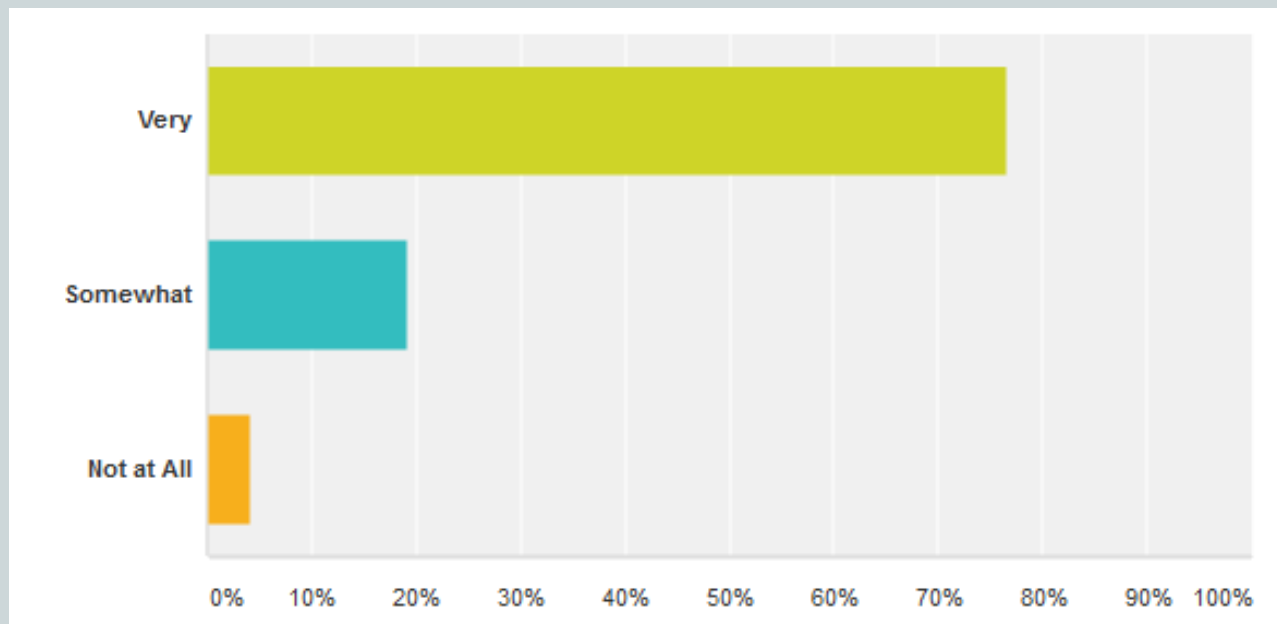

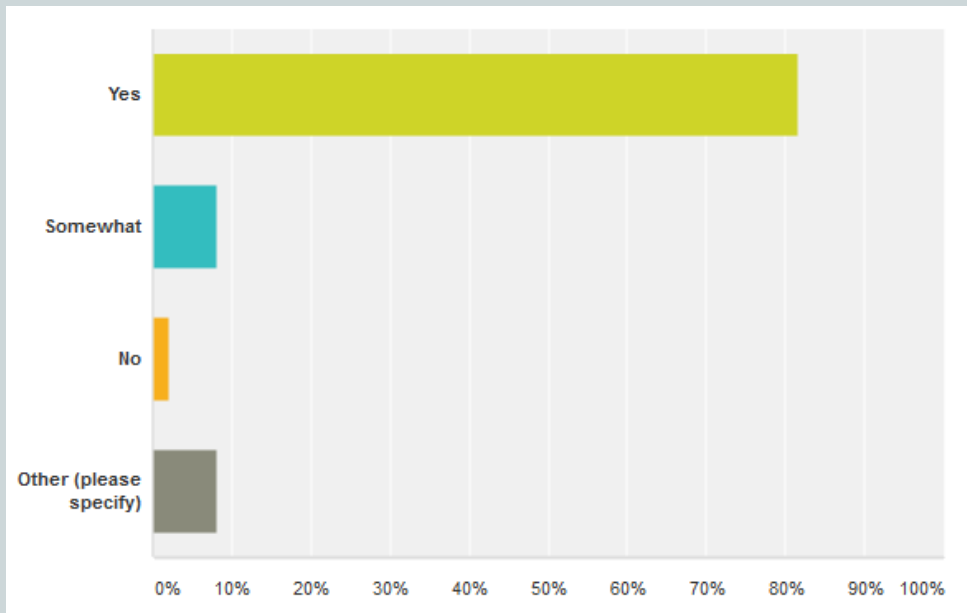
Q16: HOW SATISFIED ARE YOU WITH THE FOOD?

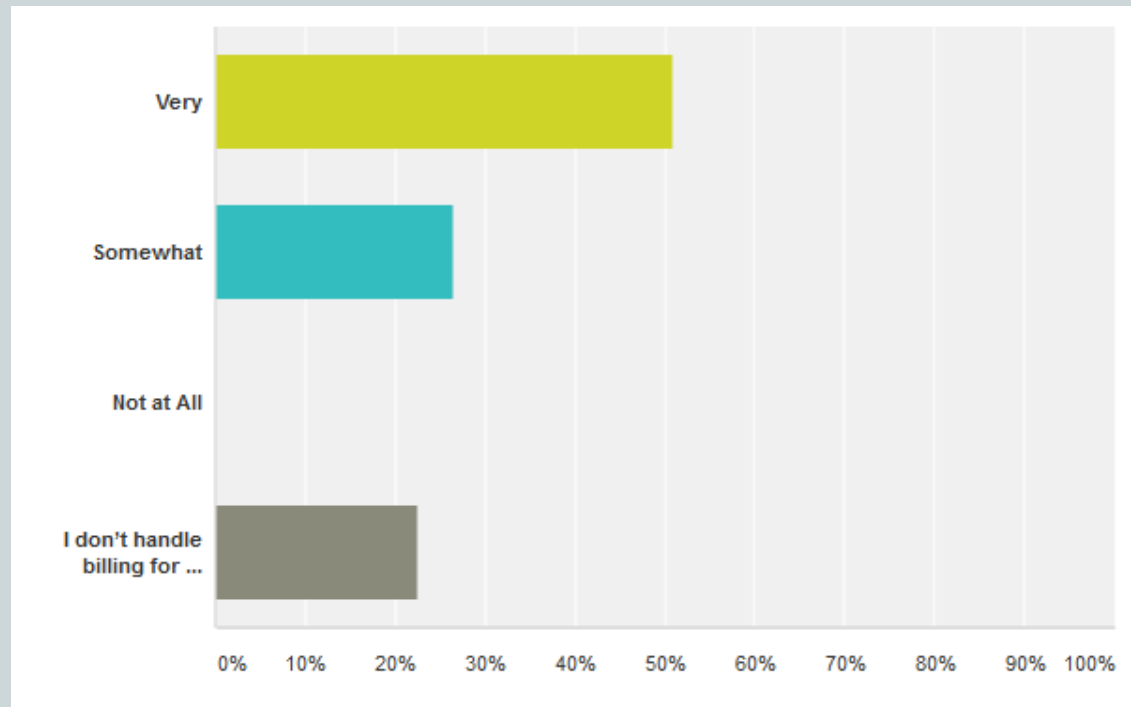
Q18: DO YOU FEEL YOUR DUES ARE BEING USED RESPONSIBLY AND MAKE THE COMMUNITY SAFER?



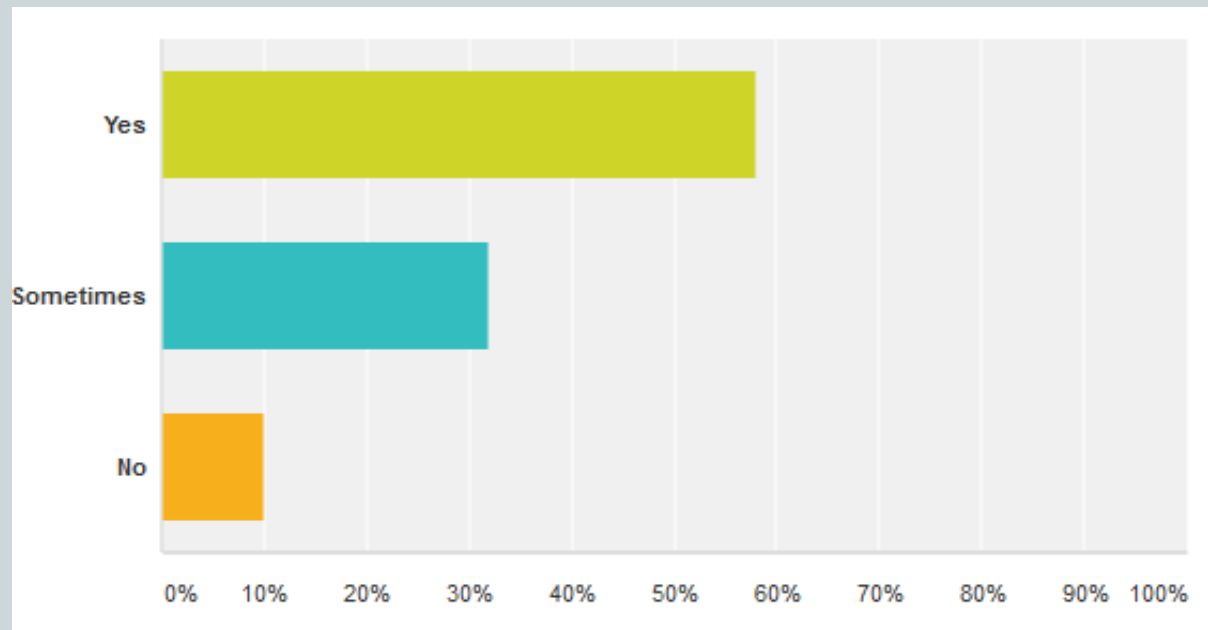
Other:

Q21: SUGGESTIONS FOR IMPROVEMENT OF THE LEPC

- More involvement is needed at the plant manager level. Members can only do so much without their involvement.
- Scholarship program for La Porte High School students
- Too many organizations: it would be helpful if the industry organizations in the area pulled together to consolidate some of the meetings and overlap activities that occur in these organizations.
- Streamline dues/members update process
- Emergency Responder Outreach program

Q21: CONTINUED

- Limit presentations to one per meeting.
- Open all meetings with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.
- Reconfigure the seating arrangements at the membership meeting.
- Foster cross communications between this LEPC & the Southeast Texas Regional LEPC. Some of the same important topics are not being shared. With a much broader audience which would equate to a more knowledgeable understanding and responsible workforce.

Q22: WHERE DO YOU FEEL THE LEPC NEEDS TO BE IN 5 YEARS?

- More industry partners involved
- More engaged with other LEPCs
- The Public Awareness Outreach should be separated; there should be an LEPC Activities committee and the LEPC Outreach committee. One focus on event planning while the other works to the betterment of organizations such as the school program, Wally, etc.
- Make sure to keep up with the growth of the area: addition of facilities that need to understand the level of involvement that is expected from a facility in this LEPC area (build up Membership Committee).

Q22: CONTINUED

- Full compliance with participation. Be more aggressive with companies that are required to participate.
- Technology improvements that are at least keeping pace with current usage by the greatest numbers of our citizens (apps, sirens still needed?, etc.)
- Emergency Responders being able to effectively use the data during emergencies.
