## **LPPD's Traffic Division represented well at State-level competition**



**LPPD Commercial Motor Vehicle inspector Dan Hoffman receives State-level honors**

After his recent April first place ranking in the Motor Carrier Safety Assistance Program's (MCSAP) Region 2 Texas Truck Challenge inspection compliance competition, LPPD commercial vehicle inspector Dan Hoffman represented the agency in similar fashion during the next step in the Challenge process.

The recent State-level competition, held in College Station during the 2<sup>nd</sup> week of June, included Hoffman finishing 1<sup>st</sup> in the MCSAP's Level 1 commercial motor vehicle (CMV) inspection competition. In addition, Hoffman placed as the #2 overall inspector and therefore qualifies as first-alternate for the upcoming MCSAP National Truck Challenge Inspection Compliance competition. The latest challenge required competitors from all over the state to participate in an identical series of events, including a Level 1 truck inspection, Level 1 passenger vehicle inspection, Non-bulk hazardous materials inspection, Cargo tank inspection, Written exam, and final interview board. All events, except the interview board, were timed and heavily scrutinized.

Hoffman's performance places him in the top 10 of all participating CMV inspectors in the State. La Porte Police Department celebrates his recent accomplishment and credits both Hoffman and the entire Traffic Division for their dedication to safety and service through continued training and personal development.
